Norris Whitlock, 2nd oldest son of the late Joe and Caroline Whitlock

was born in Jamestown, South Carolina on November 12, 1944. On the morning of September 11, 2024 at his residence in Manhattan with loved ones at his side, Norris departed this life and went home to be with the Lord at the age of 79.

Norris attended Eastern District High School and graduated along with the class of 1965. He joined the US Airforce shortly after graduating high school, served his country and received an honorable discharge on December 10, 1968. He was a very proud veteran! In addition, he also studied at the Fashion Institute of Technology. Norris was extremely talented in the arts and loved music, with Jazz and Motown being among his favorites genres. Some of his favorite artists were Marvin Gaye, The Temptations Aretha Franklin and Smokey Robinson.

On December 6, 1969, Norris married his first love, Lillie Middleton. From that union they created a beautiful daughter, Tiffany Whitlock born on October 9, 1971. Lillie Whitlock preceded him in death on June 5, 1989. In the early 70's, Norris sang with the J.M.B Mass Choir at Solomon Temple Baptist Church in the Bronx. Norris was a jack of all trades and over the course of his life, worked for several companies such as IBM, Citibank, and McGraw to name a few. He later became employed by NYC Health & Hospitals. He retired from Medical Recovery Group in 2020, he rededicated his life to Christ. He was truly a family man, loved life, family reunions, and lived life to the fullest until he became ill in 2021. Norris shared the last few decades of his life with his partner Claudine Dillard, who was by his side until his passing.

Norris leaves many behind to cherish his memories: his daughter Tiffany Whitlock, his life partner Claudine, bonus daughter Shatone Bailey, two grandchildren, Simone and Izana, two sisters, Leona Brown and Hilda, four brothers, Henry Whitlock Jr., John Whitlock, Joe Whitlock, and Willard Whitlock who preceded him in death. Four sisters-in-law, Janese Whitlock, Laura Whitlock, Gretta Whitlock, and Jane Whitlock. Two brothers-in-law Goodridge and Sinclair Brown who preceded him in death.
