

Penny's Journey to A Degree...Determination!

I am writing a short story regarding my long journey to receiving my bachelor's degree at sixty-two years of age. Mommy Daisy tried her best to encourage me to go to college right after high school. I did begin that August, however I discovered I was expecting my first baby, and I left college.

It wasn't until I was around the age of 30 that I truly had a desire to further my education. I enrolled in college, majoring in Human Services. The first semester, I got all A's...4.0. The sad part was that I had to take one

remedial algebra, which I just could not comprehend. Semester after semester, I did great in every class except algebra, so eventually I left college.

Though I worked, I felt I was capable of more. Several years later, I made up my mind that I was going back, that I was going to pass algebra. Once again, I enrolled in that same college. This time, I found myself in a relationship that was abusive, physically and emotionally, I had to leave...which also meant leaving college again. This time I thought, the degree was not mine's to pursue or achieve.

Many years later, I began looking at ads for schools, I thought about it off and on. One day I came across two of the saddest cases of child abuse, that of Aniya Day Garette and Gabriel Fernandez. To work as a Child Protective Specialist, you must have a bachelor's degree. Once again, I enrolled in college with a goal to work for the Agency for Children's Services (ACS). I was on a mission to help as many children and families as I could. My son's feared for my safety, one of my daughter's reminded me that I could not save every child.

During my time at Lehman College, I learned so much, yes there's of course the academic learning...however, even at my age, there was still life learning and so much spiritual growth. While in attendance at Lehman, two of my true good friends transitioned. During my last two semesters, my landlord had me in housing court because he wanted the apartment for his relatives. I fell and broke my ankle into five pieces which landed me back in the wheelchair for a while and sadly my Mommy Era transitioned.

Through it all...I completed all requirements and credits for my BA on December 20, 2024. The ceremony was on May 29, 2025. I graduated with a BA in Interdisciplinary Studies with a concentration in Psychology and a minor in Early Childhood Education.

All Praise to God

I was also invited to participate in a program entitled Project LAW, which was 10 weeks. This program prepares one for Law school, I completed it this past February, March and April with a grade average of 96%.

I was hired by ACS around the middle of April; I am supposed to begin training in September. As I am going through the On boarding steps as a CPS worker, I am also working along with the college towards pursuing Law, I will have to decide between the two...either way, my goal is to assist children and families.


In closing, I would like to ask that everyone please pray for the children and families.


NEW ADDITION TO THE GRAY FAMILY




Cindy Vasquez


