

First and foremost, the Whitlock-Ginn-Rodd (WGR) Board extends our heartfelt thanks to Isaac Smith and Geraldine Brown for their tireless dedication, hard work, and unwavering commitment to maintaining Hickory Hill Cemetery. Thanks to their efforts, this sacred ground remains a peaceful and respectful place for families and friends to visit and honor their loved ones.

Hickory Hill Cemetery spans just over an acre. The land was originally used by slave masters to bury enslaved individuals, and over time, our ancestors continued that tradition, laying their loved ones to rest here. The current heirs have graciously allowed it to be used for its current purpose, as they too have family members who passed away on this land, including during the Civil War.

Unfortunately, many African-American cemeteries have fallen into neglect and disrepair, only to be erased by the development of homes, apartment complexes, highways, and railroads. This is a painful reality we must work to avoid.
